



Improving Transportation



The 29th District of New York has a strong transportation infrastructure that is critical to the economic development of the entire state. Because of this, I have made transportation one of his top priorities as your Congressman.



Federal Aviation Administration Reauthorization Act of 2007

Federal Aviation Administration
Reauthorization Act of 2007 authorizes funding for the FAA for 2008 through 2011. The act will improve aviation safety and capacity, and provide stable funding for the national aviation system. And it provides valuable funding for various local airport improvements in the 29th District including runway repairs, taxiway rehabilitations, congestion relief, and increased lighting at airports.

Water Resources Development Act

The Water Resources Development Act, passed by the House this fall, includes funding for high-priority water projects at six locations around the 29th District. These projects will help eliminate the threat of flooding, and will also bolster economic development by extending and upgrading water supply systems. The inclusion of these projects in this bill will ensure that further money will not be taken from the already strained local tax base.

Appalachian Regional Development Act Amendments of 2007

I voted for this bill to provide \$463 million for the Appalachian Regional Commission through fiscal 2011. The ARC works with many states, including New York, to create opportunities for selfsustaining economic development and improved quality of life by running a highway program in isolated areas.

Congressman Randy Kuhl: Addressing our Priorities Improving Access to Quality Education



The 29th District of New York is home to many of the best schools, colleges, and universities in the nation. As a member of the Committee on Education and Labor and former Chair of the New York State Senate's Committee on Education, I am working on several pieces of legislation to strengthen the education system in the United States.



Rural Education Achievement Program (REAP)

REAP, created as part of the No Child Left Behind Act, helps rural school districts that lack the resources to apply for federal competitive grants and do not have access to large amounts of funding due to small populations. On September 17, I introduced legislation to reauthorize and improve this program.

College Affordability Tax Relief Act of 2007

Having put three children through college, I know how challenging it is to pay for higher education. That's why I introduced the College Affordability Tax Relief Act of 2007. It makes permanent the deduction for tuition and related expenses.

College Cost Reduction and Access Act

More Americans from all walks of life are pursing a college education, so it was important for me to vote for the College Cost Reduction and Access Act. The legislation will boost college aid by roughly \$20 billion over the next five years. It also increases the Pell Grant Scholarships and significantly cuts interest rates.

No Child Left Behind (NCLB)

The reauthorization of the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001 is scheduled for this fall. As a member of the Subcommittee on Early Childhood, Elementary and Secondary Education, I am playing a substantial role in this process. I believe it is vital that we improve student achievement, and plan to support efforts to expand state and local flexibility and enhance competitiveness initiatives to ensure a strong workforce.
